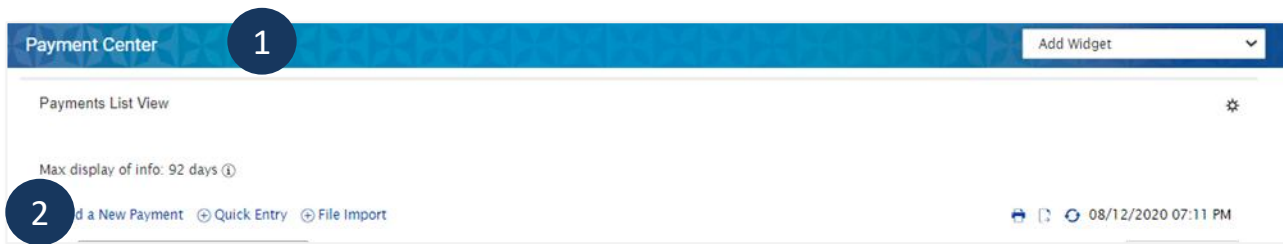


## Wire - Domestic Payments

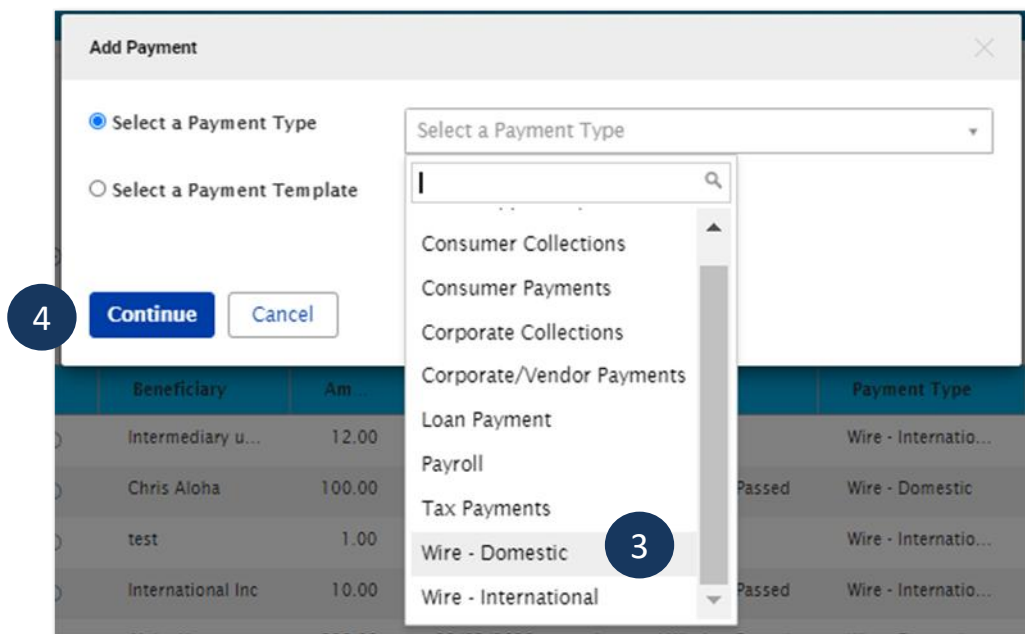
A domestic wire payment creates an electronic funds transfer between accounts at different financial institutions within the United States.

### Creating a Domestic Wire Payment

1. From **Payments/Transfers**, select **Payment Management** which will take you to the **Payment Center**.
2. Click **Add a New Payment**.



3. From the **Add Payment** modal, select **Wire - Domestic** from **Select a Payment Type**.



4. Click **Continue**.

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5. Enter payment information on the **New Wire Domestic Payment** page.

### 6. **Originator Information**

- **Account Number** - Select an account from the dropdown menu or use the lookup feature. **This field is mandatory.**
  - **Account Name** - This field will display and pre-populate upon selection of the Account Number.
- **Customer Reference** - This field is optional and can be left blank (limited to 16 characters/ spaces; special characters not accepted).
- **Comments** - Information in this field is stored with the transaction but not forwarded with the payment.

### 7. **Beneficiary Information**

- **Name** - Enter the beneficiary name or search for a payee from the beneficiary address book by using the lookup feature. If you select an entry from the beneficiary address book, some of the remaining fields will automatically populate. **This field is mandatory.**
- **Beneficiary Address, Country** - Enter the physical address and country for the beneficiary. For domestic wires, the Country will be UNITED STATES. **Address Line 1, Country and City are mandatory.**
- **Account Number** - Enter the beneficiary's bank account number. **This field is mandatory.**
- **Bank Code** - Defaults to ABA. For domestic wires, ABA will always be used as Bank

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Code.

- **Bank Routing** - Enter the bank routing number (ABA) of the beneficiary's bank. Entering three numbers will narrow your search. Or you can input the beneficiary bank name to search.
- **Date & Amount**
  - **Value Date** - The earliest possible Value Date will automatically be selected. You can enter a different Value Date (MM/DD/YYYY) or select a date using the calendar icon. **This field is mandatory.**

**Note:** Future dated wires adhere to Bank of Hawaii parameters, which is five business days.

- **Credit Amount** - Enter the amount (in US Dollars). **This field is mandatory.**
- **Post Date** - The Post Date will prepopulate with the Value Date.

## 8. Additional Information

- **Payment Details** – Enter any payment details that you want to accompany the payment (per field, limited to 35 characters/spaces; special characters not accepted). These fields are combined and submitted as a single line of details. A preview below the fields allows you to see how all the fields will appear when combined. These fields are optional and can be left blank. Payment Details will be forwarded to the beneficiary.

- **Bank-to-Bank Details** – Enter any bank-to-bank instructions that you want to accompany the payment (per field, limited to 35 characters/spaces; special characters not accepted). These fields are combined and sent as consolidated groups of instructions. A preview below the fields allows you to see how all the fields will appear when combined. These fields are optional and can be left blank. Bank-to-Bank Details will be forwarded to the beneficiary bank.

### 9. **Summary Section**

- **Save this payment as a template for future use** - Select checkbox to create a template.
  - The template will be created when the payment is submitted. Templates will not be created if the payment is Saved for Later.
    - **Template Code** - Enter a unique name for the template. The name must be alphanumeric, cannot contain spaces or special characters, and is limited to 35 characters.
    - **Template Description** - Enter a description for the template. The description is limited to 35 characters.
  - **Save For Later** - Payment information can be saved in **Incomplete** status for modification at a later date.
  - **Submit** - Click Submit to submit the payment.
10. A message will appear in a green notification bar. A payment must be approved before it is sent to the beneficiary.

## Approving a Domestic Wire Payment

The wire payment approval process is based on payment permissions.

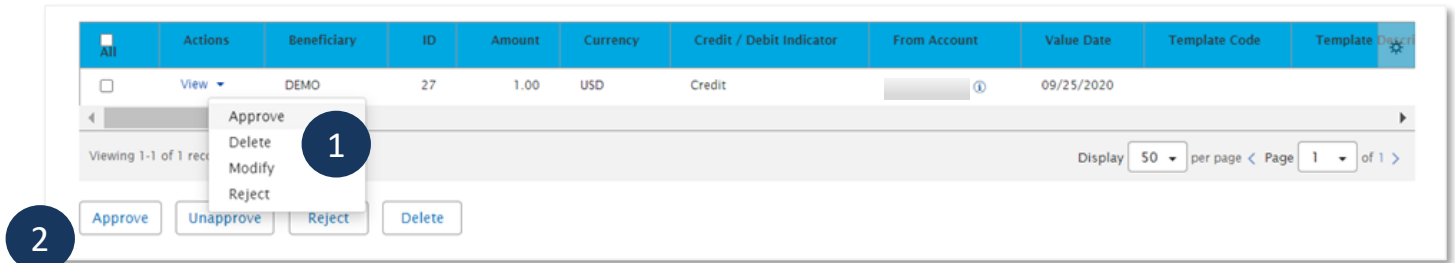
- As a User, you may have permission to either enter and edit a wire, release a wire, or approve a wire.
  - Your company may require either one or multiple levels of authentication. If two or more levels of authentication are required, the same User may not be able to perform the same level of approval. Not all Users may have approval privileges.
  - If the User is required to use Token Authentication at wire release, BBC will prompt the User for additional information, such as your User ID as well as your Authorization Code, also known as your token code.
  - All wires require a secondary approver who is not the same person as the person entering the wire.
1. If you are an approver, you will see that you have an approve option in the drop-down list. You may also have options to **Delete**, **Modify** or **Reject** the payment.
  2. To approve the payment, click on **Approve** or place a check mark on the check box next to the payment and click on the **Approve** button. This method will allow you to approve multiple wires at the same time. A confirmation message will appear in a green notification

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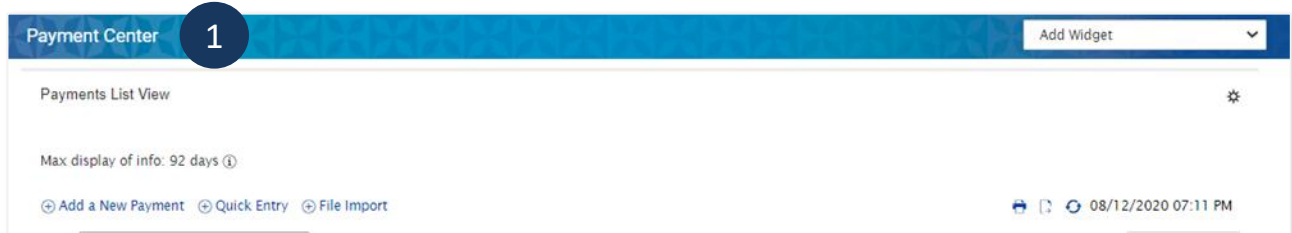

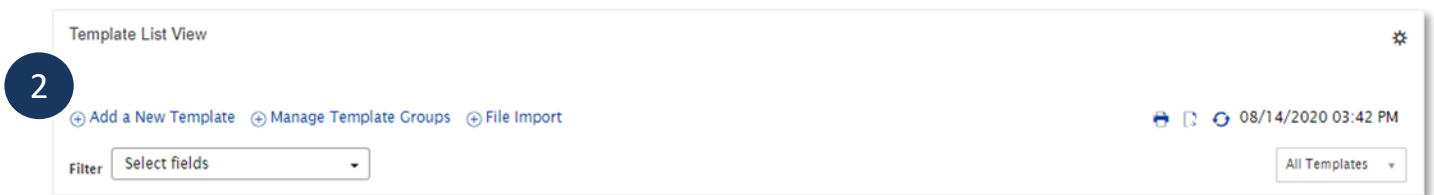
## Creating a Domestic Wire Template

1. From **Payments/Transfers**, select **Payment Management** which will take you to the **Payment Center**.



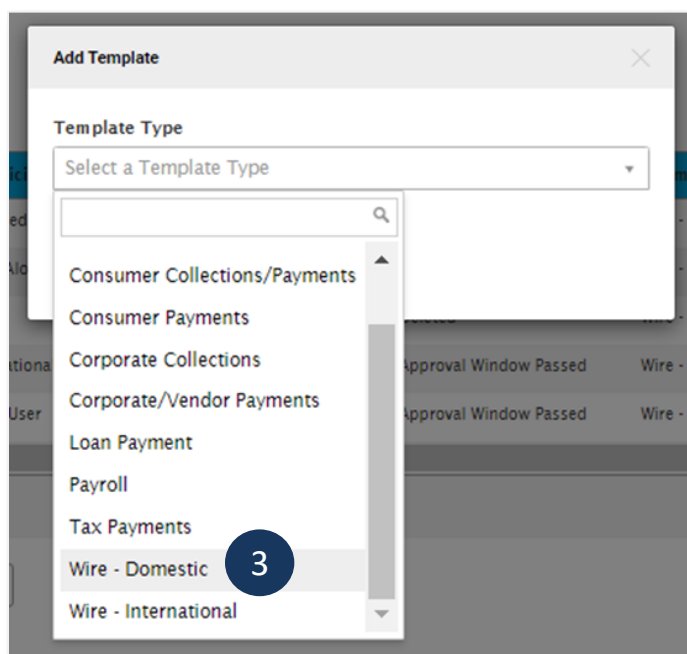
2. In the **Template List View** widget, click **Add a New Template**.



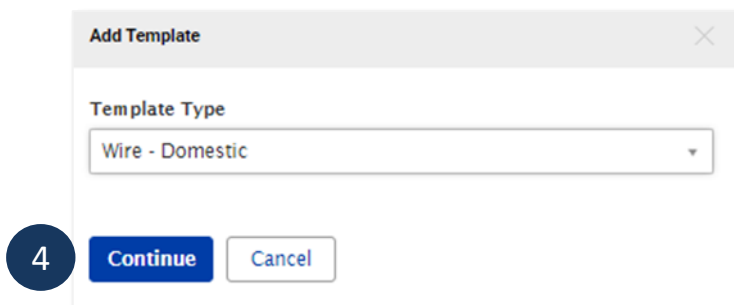

#### 4. Template Information

- **Template Code** - Enter a unique name for the template. The name must be alphanumeric, cannot contain spaces or special characters, and is limited to 35 characters. **This field is mandatory.**
- **Template Description** - Enter a description for the template. The description is limited to 35 characters/spaces. **This field is mandatory.**
- **Restrict** - Check **Restrict** to restrict template to users who are explicitly entitled to it.

#### 5. Originator Information

- **Account Number** - Select an account from the dropdown menu or use the lookup feature. **This field is mandatory.**
  - **Account Name** - Account Name field will display and pre-populate upon selection of the Account Number.
  - **Client Account Name** - Client Account Name field will display and pre-populate upon selection of the Account Number.
- **Customer Reference** - This field is optional and can be left blank (limited to 16 characters/ spaces; special characters not accepted).

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- **Internal Comment** - Information in this field is stored with the transaction but not forwarded with the payment.

## 6. Beneficiary Information

- **Name** - Enter the beneficiary name or search for a payee from the beneficiary address book by using the lookup feature. If you select an entry from the beneficiary address book, some of the remaining fields will automatically populate. **This field is mandatory.**
- **Beneficiary Address, Country** - Enter the physical address and country for the beneficiary. For domestic wires, the Country will be UNITED STATES. **Address Line 1, Country and City are mandatory.**
- **Account Number** - Enter the beneficiary's bank account number. **This field is mandatory.**
- **Bank Code** - Defaults to ABA. For domestic wires, the Bank Code will be ABA.
- **Bank Routing** - Enter the bank routing number of the beneficiary's bank. Entering three numbers or three letters will narrow your search.
- **Amount**
  - **Credit Amount** - Enter the amount (in US Dollars). This field is mandatory.

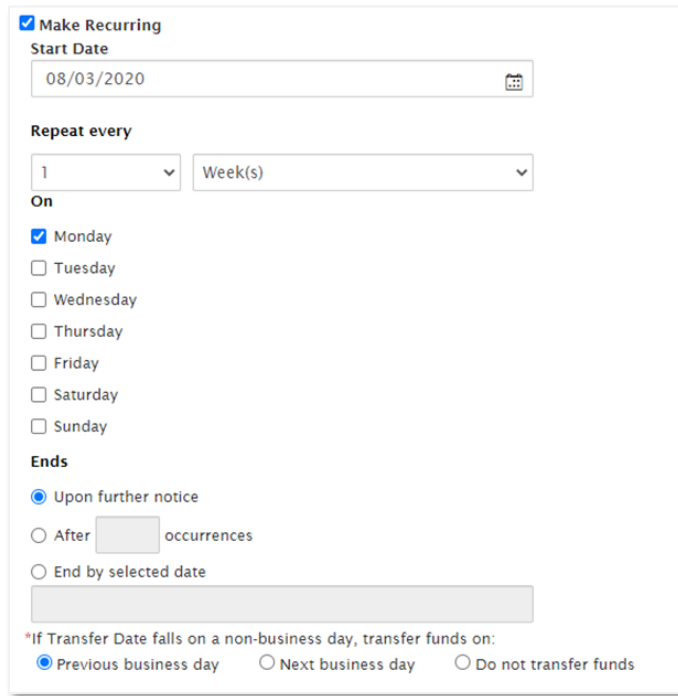

## Creating Template Groups

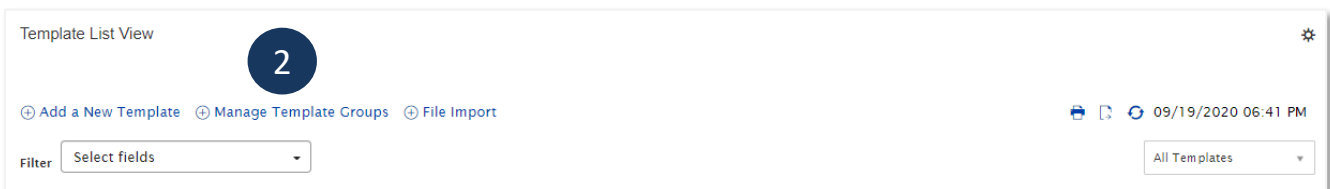
Template Groups are groups of individual wires with the same value date and are typically used when sending a number of wires at the same time.

### Creating a Template Group

1. From **Payments/Transfers**, select **Payment Management**, which will take you to the **Payment Center**.



2. In the **Template List View** widget, select **Manage Template Groups**.



3. Click Add Template Group.

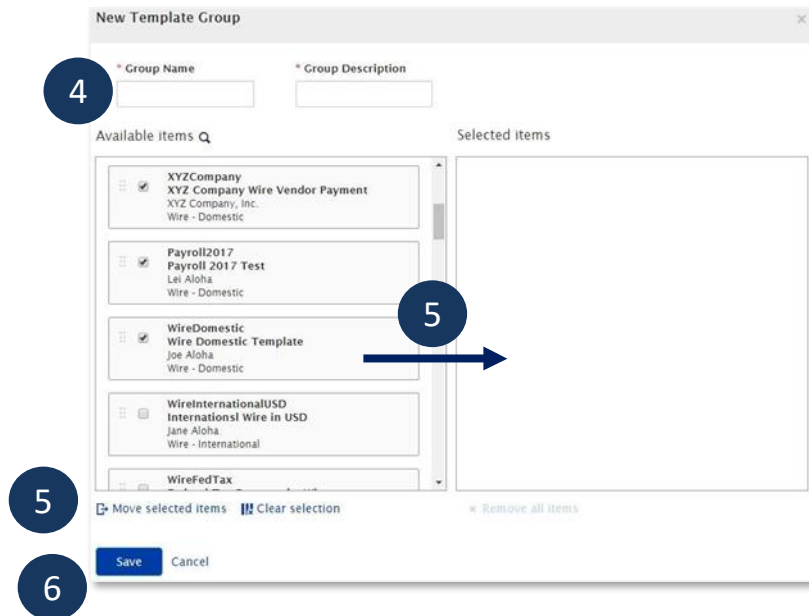


4. In the **New Template Group** modal, enter **Group Name** and Group **Description**. Enter a unique Group Name to differentiate it in your workflow.

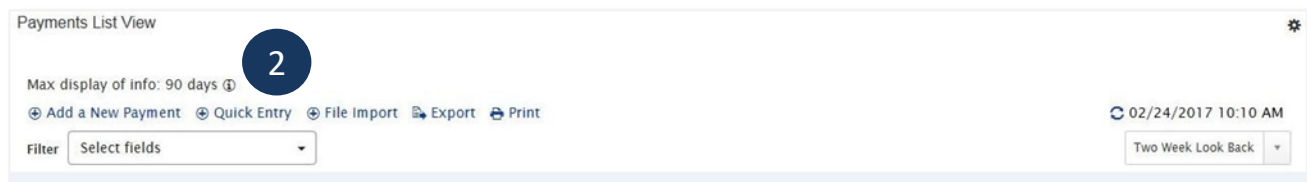
5. Click/drag selected template(s) from Available items (left column) to Selected items (right column) OR check box of selected template(s) and click Move selected items.
6. Click **Save**.

## Creating a Batch from a Template Group

1. From **Payments/Transfers**, select **Payment Management** which will take you to the **Payment Center**.



2. In the **Payments List View** widget, click **Quick Entry**.



3. From the **Template Code** dropdown menu, select a **Template/Group name**, **beneficiary** or **payment type**.
4. The earliest possible Value Date will automatically be selected. You can enter a different **Value Date** (MM/DD/YYYY) or select a date using the calendar icon.

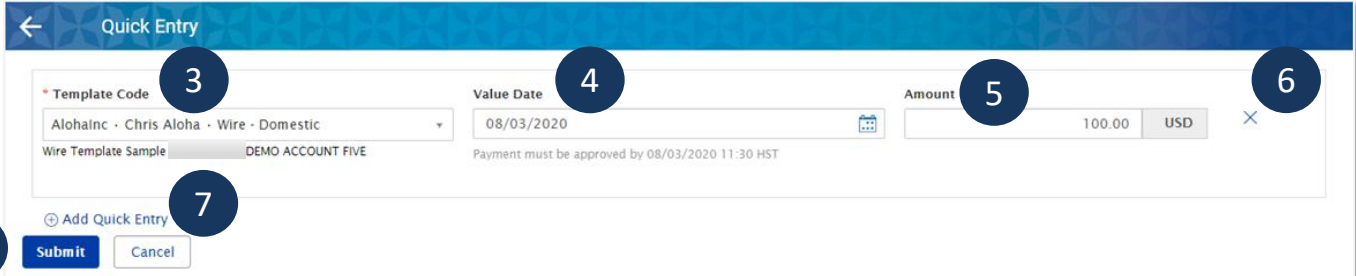

10. Based on the User's payment permissions, if the payments require additional approval, they will move into **Entered** status.

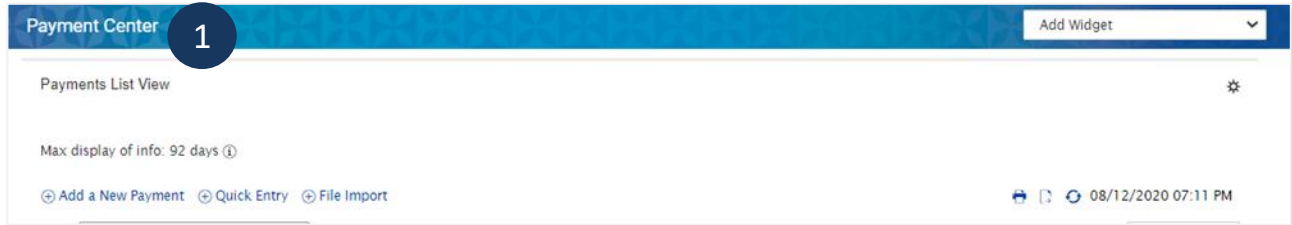

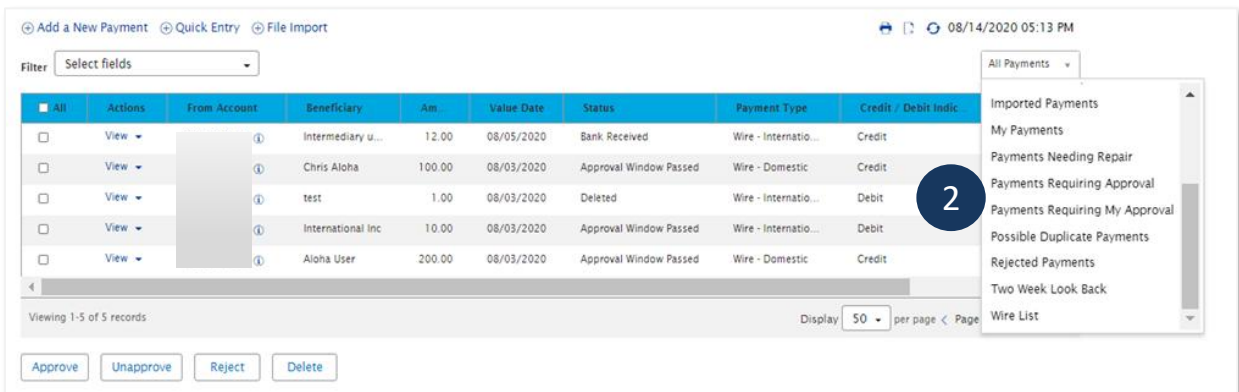


## Approving a wire created via Template Groups

1. From **Payments/Transfers**, select **Payment Management**, which will take you to the **Payment Center**.



2. In the **Payments List View** widget, select **Payments Requiring Approval** in the predefined view



3. Click the drop-down icon in the Actions column to **Approve**, **Delete**, **Modify** or **Reject** the payment.



4. You can also check the checkbox and click the **Approve**, **Unapprove**, **Reject**, or **Delete** button.
5. A confirmation message will appear in a green notification bar.
6. See “Approving a Domestic Wire Payment” for more information.

## Payment Status Definitions

| Status                            | Definition                                                                                                       |
|-----------------------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| <b><i>Entered</i></b>             | Entered without errors, ready for approval workflow. Can be modified, deleted or rejected.                       |
| <b><i>Incomplete</i></b>          | Saved in an incomplete status, for later completion. Not available for workflow. Can be modified or deleted.     |
| <b><i>Needs Repair</i></b>        | Needs repair, usually due to an error in a file import validation.                                               |
| <b><i>Incomplete Approval</i></b> | Currently in approval workflow. Not available for modification or deletion.                                      |
| <b><i>High Value</i></b>          | Requires secondary approval for high value payments. Not available for modification or deletion.                 |
| <b><i>Approved</i></b>            | Approval workflow complete. Not available for modification or deletion. Ready for extraction to back office.     |
| <b><i>Approver Rejected</i></b>   | Rejected by approver. Not available for workflow. Can be modified or deleted.                                    |
| <b><i>Deleted</i></b>             | Deleted. Not available for workflow or modification.                                                             |
| <b><i>Import In Process</i></b>   | Payments currently being imported are set to this temporary status and cannot be modified, deleted or approved.  |
| <b><i>Export In Process</i></b>   | Payments currently being extracted are set to this temporary status and cannot be modified, deleted or approved. |
| <b><i>Needs Rate</i></b>          | Needs an online rate. Available for trading and unapproved status, but cannot be modified or deleted.            |
| <b><i>Released</i></b>            | Released to the back office. Not available for deletion, modification or rejection.                              |
| <b><i>Bank Received</i></b>       | Received by the back office. Not available for deletion or modification.                                         |
| <b><i>Bank Confirmed</i></b>      | Confirmed by the back office. Not available for deletion or modification.                                        |
| <b><i>Rejected</i></b>            | Rejected by the back office. Not available for workflow, deletion, or modification.                              |
