Historical Background

Born in Honolulu, Oahu on May 7, 1951, Julia Temple Davis Brown was the third of four children born to George I'i and Julia Jones Brown. The family home, "Mililani", was located on the banks of Pearl Harbor on the I'i Ahapua'a of Waipio.

Julia attended Punahou School during her elementary years and was receiving her high school education at La Pietra Hawaii School for Girls, when she passed away in her senior year on March 22, 1969, a few months prior to graduation. Julia was 17 years old. In addition to being a teen model and a fashion show participant, Julia also had a passion for art. The yellow ginger flower represents an oil painting Julia was working on at the time of her death. The painting was to be a wedding gift for her older sister.

Following their daughter's untimely death, George and Julia Brown memorialized her name by establishing the Julia Temple Davis Brown Foundation.
